OPEN TO ALL MONROE COUNTY RESIDENTS. NO COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL WASTE.

Hazardous wastes is <u>only</u> taken at the spring cleanup, so now is the time to rid your home and garage of hazardous waste! NO household trash accepted.

Accepted items at NO charge: Households / Farms

Up to: 5 gallons waste oil & 5 gallons oil filters & 5 gallons anti-freeze – over 5 gal of ea.: .50¢/gal.

Hazardous waste: up to 250 lbs. per vehicle of any combo of the following:

Lawn & farm chemicals
Household cleaners
Insect sprays
Paints / thinners
Medications:

Pills, liquids, inhalers

All rechargeable batteries
Lithium & button batteries
(hearing aid, camera, etc.)

Car batteries

Small helium/LP tanks <20 lbs.





Acceptable Items with Fees

Tires*: 19¢/lb. or \$385/ton Mattress & Box Springs*: \$20 ea.

Bulbs: Fluorescent tubes: 8' @ \$1.00 ea. / 4' @ .50¢ ea.

HID lamps, circle fluorescent, specialty lamps, halogens: \$3 ea.

Items with NO Charge

Refrigerant-containing appliances* (freezers, refrigerators, a/c, dehumidifiers) **All other large appliances***

Electronics* (ex. computer monitors, CPU, printers, copiers) **TV's***

*Items taken all year round, Mon-Fri. 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

We will not accept the following:

- Explosives (shotgun shells, fireworks, gunpowder, Picric acid, etc.)
- Radioactive materials
- Household or construction waste or large items (couches, chairs, demolition material)

Monroe County reserves the right to charge a fee for quantities of hazardous waste over household limits of 250lbs. Prices may be subject to change.
